## SENATE EXECUTIVE MESSAGE NO. 32

Dear President Pro Tempore Jennings and Members of the Senate:

Pursuant to the Constitution of the State of New Mexico, Article IV, Section 22, I hereby VETO and am returning SENATE BILL 422, as amended, enacted during the Fiftieth Legislature, First Session, 2011.

This bill imposes a fifty-one cent 911 emergency surcharge to voice over internet protocol (VOIP) and prepaid wireless card customers.

I have pledged to New Mexicans that I would not support raising taxes as a method of generating revenue. By vetoing this measure, I am honoring that commitment.
